Clinical Experience

I have experience of working in the independent sector in my current post as an assistant psychologist in a psychology practice.

In my current post, I work within a small team of clinical psychologists who are involved in training and consultation to Local Authorities about the needs of looked after children. I am further involved with the administration and evaluation of routine psychometric and cognitive tests, training, service evaluation and development, clinical audit, and liaison with professionals i.e. CAMHS, Education (SEN) and Social Services.

As part of my role as a mentor for students on the autistic spectrum, I had several one-to-one sessions with a student there. We worked together to develop his key skills, specifically interpersonal, communication and teamwork skills. My duties included session planning, dealing with challenging



behaviour and helping my mentee deal with social conflicts and concerns. Additionally, I had to complete regular audits documenting my mentee's progress.
